



Guidelines for completing the Rotary Club of Peachland

LOCAL IMPACT GRANT APPLICATION

The purpose of the Peachland Local Impact Rotary grant is to enable local organizations to apply for grants from funds raised by the Peachland Rotary Club. Grant requests will be measured for merit of project, community betterment, and plans for future sustainability. The Rotary Club of Peachland funds projects on a one time basis. Subsequent requests for the same project are considered on their own merits and may or may not receive funding at that time. The Club prefers to fund projects/activities that result in something “that we can put our name on” i. e. tangible and visible projects.

- Local Impact Grants applications will be accepted and considered during the month following receipt.
- Proposals will only be considered for projects which benefit the citizens or the District of Peachland.
- Proposals are limited to one request per year per organization.
- Grant applications should be for project of \$1000 or less. Requests for more funding than the cap will be referred to the Rotary Club of Peachland Executive Committee for their consideration and decision.
- Grant requests between \$250 and \$1,000 will be given primary consideration.
- Priority will be given to those requests which benefit the greatest number of people.
- Grants will maximise the impact of Peachland Rotary Club’s resources donated to the Community.
- Grants will not be considered for the funding of individual needs or causes, wages or salaries, travel, operating costs or rentals, nor any project or program whose main intent is the furtherance of religious or political endeavours.
- Grants will not be considered if they are “generic” and could receive multiple funding responses from different sources/agencies/organisations.
- Successful applicants are required to submit a short feedback report on completion of the grant’s expenditure and within a month of the project’s conclusion.
- Additional information may be added to the initial grant application, however, the maximum number of pages, including the application form, should not exceed three pages.
- Additional information may be requested by the Local Impact Grant Committee prior to making a recommendation to the Executive Board.
- **The submission of a budget with the grant application is required.**
